

SANTA TERESA CATHOLIC CHURCH JUNE 10, 2018 10th Sunday in Ordinary Time

My dear Parish Family of Santa Teresa,

As I write this message to you, we will be celebrating with the whole Church the Feast of Corpus Christi: The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. How do we live the Eucharist that we receive? How do we become what we eat and drink? How do we build up the Body of Christ?

The Second Vatican Council reminds us that the Eucharist is the source and summit of our salvation. As we celebrate this most beautiful and mystery-filled feast of our faith, we should take the time to read the 6th Chapter of John's Gospel, which is all about the Eucharist. When people do not practice or abandon the Catholic Faith, they also separate themselves from the Eucharist and Jesus tells us in John's 6th Chapter: Unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood, you do not have life within you. Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood will live forever.

Starting June 1st, Friday, every Friday after the morning 8:30 am Mass we will pray the Rosary of Intercession and Healing, meditating on the sorrowful mysteries. St. Paul says: When one part of the body suffers, the whole body

suffers. The Rosary will be our prayer for all those who suffer and ask us to remember them in prayer, in union with the sufferings of Christ. There are other opportunities for us to build up the body of Christ through prayer, the Bible and the Sacraments at Santa Teresa. Every Tuesday after the morning Mass we have Lectionary based Scripture Study. At 11 am on Tuesdays, we have an hour of adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. On the first Saturday of the month we have Mass at 8:30 am with the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Every Saturday, from 4:30 to 5 pm, we have individual confessions.



Every part of the body is important to the whole. What we do, give and share benefits the entire body of Christ.

May the 'Amen' we say come from our hearts to receiving, remembering and living the Eucharist.
